Did you know ... today, thanks to you, trees are growing in Niger, plumbers are being trained in Guatemala and schoolchildren in Mozambique are drinking clean safe water? All through the 2012 Lent appeal. Your generosity, matched by the UK Government, raised £18.6 million for projects in 24 countries.
