Church Insurance

We have received correspondence from the Diocese regarding the increase in the number of fire damage claims caused by lighted candles in our churches. We were asked to look at our arrangements and improve them where possible. To that end we had some tiled boards made to put below the candle stands to replace the existing rugs, these have been in place for a few months. Our thanks to John Rowell (Kirsty's Father-in-Law) who made them and to Superdec who donated the tiles. Also, we have now had installed an extra layer of shelving on the two candle stands to allow the tall, weekly candles to be placed on the top shelf, away from wooden plinths and wooden statues. Our thanks to Tony Messenger who made the shelves & brackets and to Robert Goulding who put it all together. Therefore, in future, ALL lighted candles MUST ONLY be situated on the candle stands & Susan O'Neill will be responsible for lighting the weekly candles for us.
